TAX ASSISTANCE

If you are a non-resident alien and we are unable to help you with your tax return due to out-of-state income or any other limiting factor, you may wish to use Sprintax, which is sponsored by International Student & Scholar Services:

Sprintax tax preparation software, online

International students and scholars can prepare their federal tax return and 8843 form online using Sprintax. This service is free for current UConn students and scholars, as well as recent graduates who are on post-completion OPT, or Academic Training. Sprintax can also prepare your state tax return for a fee. Sprintax prepares tax forms for individuals who are non-residents for tax purposes. The software will have you complete a short questionnaire to determine whether you qualify. You will need to request an access code from ISSS to complete your tax return preparation. Email international@uconn.edu if you would like to request an access code and a link to the Sprintax portal.

This is also your best option if you need to file from out of the country on your first year back home.
